

Important Information for Recreational Vehicle Owners:

The Worimi Conservation Lands Recreational Vehicle Area (RVA) has been amended to enhance public safety and the protection of natural and cultural values. This change also provides increased recreational opportunities for RV operators.

This means the area where people can ride conditionally registered quad bikes, motor bikes, dune buggies and other recreational vehicles has increased by 48%. The RVA retains 4 kms of beach front south of Lavis Lane to the 'Sygna Wreck', and now includes the high dune area south-west of the Lavis Lane entrance.



Please remember:

- You must obtain RTA conditional registration for all quad bikes, motor bikes, dune buggies and other recreational vehicles (RV's) ~ to ride/drive at Stockton Beach in the Worimi Conservation Lands (WCL).
- Your RV must clearly display an RTA registration plate, and a current WCL 'Recreational Vehicle Permit'.
- You must operate your conditionally registered RV in the 'RVA' only (refer to map). It is illegal to operate RV's elsewhere in the WCL.
- A max. speed limit of 40km/hr applies to Stockton Beach in the WCL. Reduce speed to 20km/hr within 100m from pedestrians & other vehicles. Obey all speed limits.
- It is illegal for unregistered vehicles (including RV's) to operate anywhere in the Worimi Conservation Lands. This includes the RVA.

*On-the-spot fines apply.
Offenders may be prosecuted.*
